Introduction

Before you get started reading the heavy stuff let me tell you a few things about myself, because the heavy stuff is deep and you will want to know something about who wrote it. I was born December 28th, 1938 on a plantation somewhere near Osceola, Arkansas. Before my first birthday, my parents had bought a farm in Lake View, Arkansas, where I was raised in a fashion second to none before coming to Chicago just before my 18th birthday. According to my mother and older siblings, who were on the scene at the time, I was the first born of identical twins, but according to our birth certificates my brother was the first born. Since the death of our mother in 1983, that discrepancy has been the source of heated ongoing arguments between my brother and me. He never brought it up as long as our Mother was living, but now he wants to be the first born, which would promote him to the original twin and demote me to generic status, but I am not having no parts of it. He is seventy-six years old and I am seventy-six years young...but that's enough about my twin. If you want to know more about him, you will have to wait and read my memoir that I've completed and am in the process of trying to get it published.

I was nineteen and my wife was sixteen when we got married in the spring of 1958 and some of our relatives and friends said it wouldn't last six months.

I must admit the going has been rough at times but we are still together and love and appreciate each other more with each passing year. We are a blessed family with five successful kids, fourteen grandchildren and six great-grandchildren. I also have two successful sons outside of our marriage and three grandchildren from them. I am a Chicago Transit Authority, CTA, retiree where I worked as a motorman for twenty-five years. My hobbies are playing chess, dominoes, pinochles, and arguing with my twin brother about nothing. I am a firm believer in God the Creator but I don't believe in religion. I believe that God has only one Divine law, and that is that we do that which is right, and any manmade law that does not comply with that Divine law is unjust and is bound to cause friction and peace is unlikely.

I consider myself to be an African-American activist although I am not affiliated with any organization or movement at this time. I intend to change that by establishing a ministry to carry out my mission of uniting my people under one God, and that is one of the reasons I am writing this book. I was a member of the Nation of Islam from 1960 until 1968. My twin brother, Hakeem Muhammad

(Lesley), and I joined the Nation of Islam at the same time and he is still active in the Muslim community.

My twin and I have totally different concepts of God and religion but we have learned to respect each other's beliefs. Learning to respect each other's beliefs didn't come easy as there was a time that we didn't communicate with each other for several years only because of that. My belief in God is based on the logic that nothing comes from nothing and the universe is something and it had to come from something and what so ever that something is regardless of shape, form, or fashion, is the Creator and the true and living God. My Brother's belief in God is founded in the teaching of Elijah Muhammad and the Nation of Islam. They believe that God is a Man named W.D. Fard, although mainstream ethnic Muslims do not share this belief. I was a follower of Elijah for almost eight years and I never believed that God was a man but I never let any of the Believers know it. You might think that anyone who believes that God is a Man would have to be off-center or a little wacky but they might feel the same way about you. Your God could be perceived as no more than a fictional character like Superman or Santa Claus. I have learned to respect everyone's beliefs, even if they believe that a broom is God, but I believe there is only one God, God the Creator and he has no

name, but a title, “The Creator”, and all other Gods are false Gods.

I know this might sound like a script from the Blues Brothers movie but I have a mission from God. My mission is to unite my people under one God by teaching them the faith of Truth, and the main trick in doing that is to stay a step ahead of the man wearing the white jacket. This book has some heavy stuff in it and I have attempted to mix in a pinch of humor to make it easier to digest without taking away from the seriousness of The Message. I could have made this book bigger by elaborating more on many of the topics. Instead, I decided to compact The Message while maintaining its essence for the reading convenience of the average African-American reader. I am writing this book as a first step in assisting me in starting a ministry to address the ailments of our people. Prologue

Now let me prepare you for the heavy stuff by first warming you up with a little politics; for those of you who do not understand the slang “heavy stuff”, I am referring to ideologies. For those of you who do not know the meaning of the word “manifesto”, it means a public declaration of policy or views. Our beliefs are one of the main ingredients that make us who we are; and some of us change our beliefs from time to time, especially as we mature. There are others, such as the fanatically religious, who seldom change their beliefs. There is also a large population searching for something to believe in. I have been one of the latter for many years, and I would like to share with you some of the things that I have surmised in my journey.

Some of my insights may sound controversial, but I can assure you that it is not my intention to slander or disrespect anyone’s faith. Our faith is what Religion we believe in or how we perceive God. I recognize the importance of an individual’s faith, and no one should undermine another person’s faith unless they have something better to offer. I am offering you the faith of TRUTH and hoping that you will accept it in place of your religious faith. I will explain clearly what I mean by the “truth” in the

content of this book. I believe that rational logic is the key to unlocking the truth. I am referring to logic “like two plus two equals four”, and not fuzzy logic like two plus two equal one, or whatever you want it to equal. If your belief is based on rational logic, then you can keep an open mind in defending it, because truth never contradicts truth. Yet, if your belief is based on fuzzy logic you must keep your mind closed to the truth because there is no logical defense. This is why the United States is in its current political quagmire.

I believe Democracy is the best form of government. A true Democracy is a government of the people, by the people, for the people. The founders of this country had the right idea but did not live up to that idea and our fore parents who were bought here as slaves can attest to that. Instead of establishing a Democracy, they established a White Supremacist government and despite of all the progress we, the African-Americans, have made, there lies the problem even to this day. This country’s two party political system was running along fine until African-Americans started demanding civil rights in the 1960’s and 70’s, this shook up the two party system into what we have today.

Before the civil rights movement, the South would always vote for the Democrats because they

knew that the Democrats best represented the poor. The Southern States were and still are the poorest States in the Union. The Civil Rights movement had its greatest success during the 60s under two Democratic Presidents, Kennedy and Johnson, and that left the White Southerners with a dilemma; do they switch over to the Republicans and become worse off economically or remain with the Democrats who seem to no longer uphold their true value, racism. All through the 70s the White Racists in the South and throughout the land were lost as to which party best suited them and they were in need of a leader; Reagan to the rescue. In 1976 Ronald Reagan ran for president as a liberal and didn't survive the Republican Primary, but the next time around, him and his conniving buddies had it all figured out. They brought together the White Racists, who were mostly poor but many, and the Rich Capitalists, who owned nearly everything but were few. Together, they forged the perfect marriage from hell, and called it conservatism. He ran a blatant racist campaign as a conservative and won by carrying the Southern States, and now the Republican Party has become the flag ship for the White Racists throughout the land.

There are two camps diametrically opposite each other; they call themselves liberals and conservatives.

There can never be a meeting of the minds between these two parties because one tries to use rational logic while the other one uses fuzzy logic. These two parties are so far opposed that there is no middle ground. It is an ideological civil war, and like in any civil war, there is no place for neutrality. Anyone who claims to be a moderate, and quite a few people do, is most likely a conservative with a bad conscience.

The Republican Party is run by the wealthy for the wealthy and uses race baiting to attract their large following. Just as in fishing, the Republicans dangle racism like a worm on a hook with hopes of attracting white voters- most of whom are poor and would swear that they are not racist. The art of race baiting was perfected by President Ronald Reagan, the great communicator himself. He effectively communicated to the racists that he was against the Blacks simply by not campaigning in our neighborhood or not even attempting to win our votes. The great communicator even had the audacity to make a Black Woman, who had cheated on welfare, one of his main campaign characters by dubbing her the welfare queen. He even communicated to big business that it was open season on the working class and their unions by firing the striking air traffic controllers. This heralded

president succeeded in creating the largest gap between the rich and the poor that had ever existed- the rich got richer and the poor get poorer. True to form, those poor Peckerwoods that got poorer under his first administration turned right around and voted for him again and will swear to this day that he was the greatest president of our time! The Southern States, with their deep rooted racism, is a perfect example of what I am speaking of. For years the Southern States voted Democratic but when the Blacks started demanding their rights, they turned Republican overnight.

The conservative will target what they want to do, regardless of how morally and socially wrong it is, and offer fuzzy logic to justify their position. You can't reason with them because they don't use rational logic; to argue the obvious is futile. You can't talk to them you have to talk at them. They are a very tight knit group that finds strength and comfort in their camaraderie and think that the world is out to get them. It is not the world that is out to get them, but time is closing in on them and time is undefeated. They call themselves conservative, but they really are nothing but modern day revisionists who would like to turn time all the way back to slavery if they could. We, the Black people, should be acutely aware of the perilous and precarious position we're in, and don't

be naïve and think that we are impervious to harm or even a holocaust of some sort. We shouldn't put too much faith in our White liberal counterpart as they do not have as much at stake as we do and can switch camps in short notice...and often do. The ideology of Western Civilization is founded on fuzzy logic enforced by might makes right! However, there is a new world on the horizon; the major powers have finally realized the stupidity of mutual destruction and people have lost their fear to think, and have opened up their minds to new thoughts and ideas.

I believe that God the Creator has brought us to this critical junction where we must choose one direction or another. It is easy for one to see which way is the right way, but if they harden their hearts to the truth nothing can change them. Racism is wrong and has no place in the new emerging world, but the conservatives would like to reserve it. They think that God meant for it to stay that way. They are constantly evoking the founding fathers, and think that we should share their enthusiasm regardless of the fact that they were the ones who enslaved our forefathers. We should be very much concerned because the conservative has already demonstrated that they are not going to cooperate with the liberal in our two party systems. They have created the kind of atmosphere that fascism and dictators spring up from.

I am not saying this just to try and frighten you but we should let history be our guide and try and take our destiny into our own hands and stop being totally dependent on others. We should learn something from the devastating storm Sandy that hit New York City and other areas on the East Coast. Every time you turned your TV on, you heard them talking about all the areas of New York City but not once did you hear them mention the word Harlem, a predominately Black community. I am sure we all hope that America will change many of its bad policies of the past at home and abroad, and there have been great stride made in the right direction, but there is one bad policy of the past that might be the downfall of this civilization and we should be aware of how it might affect us, the African-American people.

That bad policy dates back to the late nineteen-forties in the Middle East, shortly after the Second World War. While the White World was doing the right thing by granting independence to the people of color who had endured over a hundred years of colonization in that region, they were doing the wrong thing towards one of their formal Colonies and time will not make it right. They took this formal Colony land that they had lived on for over a thousand years and gave it to another people whose

only claim was based upon some biblical writing dating back thousands of years. And now this newly created country poses the world greatest danger to Western Civilization. It holds the world's best known secret, a stockpile of nuclear weapons, while the Western Nations looks the other way, and if there is a nuclear conflict it is most likely to be the culprit to start it. The Western Nations that created this new Nation now find themselves in the same predicament as the movie character, Dr. Frankenstein, when he tried to create a man. As for a do-over, they can forget about it, just as in the case of Dr. Frankenstein's creation, their creation is not going to stand for no disassembling and they have stockpiles of the world best known secret to back them up.

While we, the African-American people, should observe what's going on around the world we should be careful not to become entangled in it, we have enough problems right here at home. It would be wise for us to get our act together while Obama is in office because we don't know who or what might follow him and we shouldn't be caught with our guards down. There could be no better example of the Republican disdain for us then when we were mourning the death of a great civil rights activist and Supreme Court Justice, Thurgood Marshall, they didn't hesitate to add insult to injuries by appointing

Uncle Thomas himself to replace him, and we know whose side he's on.

I realize this book will cause some controversy but that could be a good thing because controversy usually precedes changes and that is what we, the African-American people, are in dire need of; and that is the purpose of this book. It is not my intention to insult anyone, but the truth must be told before my people can be saved from their predicament, and for that, I offer no apologies. I encourage you to read with an open mind and I know that you will gain something from it.

THE FAITH OF TRUTH

I have been on a long journey in search of the right path. On my journey, I have used truth as my compass by formulating the simple hypothesis that truth never contradicts truth. In my search, God has revealed to me the Faith of Truth and has made it my mission to deliver the truth to you. The dictionary describes only three different beliefs of God, atheist, agnostic, and religious believer, and God has reveal to me a forth belief in this genre that is not found in the dictionary. I call it the True Believer; a True Believer is a person who believes in God but do not believe in religion, and Truth is their only tenet. Unlike Religions, Truth is the natural faith of God and it is through Truth that we know God. Religious faith is from man and is not universal. It is the cause of many wars and turmoil in the world. The faith of Truth is from God and is universal, and is the only Faith that can secure peace in the world. The basic difference between Religious Faiths and the Faith of Truth is Religious Faiths are built on myth and is irrational, and the Faith of Truth is built on truth and is rational. We are now living in the day of reckoning and we must decide which faith we want to embrace. The faith of Truth is a natural faith, it doesn't require any rituals or hooplas, it only requires

that you believe that there is only one God, God the Creator, and he has no associates, and that you obey the laws of the land and serve God by trying to do right. When you accept Truth as your faith you should be referred to as a True Believer because you believe in Truth, the same as those who believe in Christianity are called Christians, Judaism Jewish, and ECT. The next time I am asked the question, what faith am I, I will declare Truth as my faith. God is independent of religion and is on the side of Truth. The truth may sometime be like a bitter pill but it is from God and it will heal our ills.

In order for you to get a better concept of the term Faith of Truth, I will elaborate on the two words, faith, and truth. What is faith? According to the dictionary, faith means (1) allegiance, (2) confidence, which means that you can have faith in anything, but it doesn't make it true just because you have faith in it. Religions defy logic and common sense and try to scare the crap out of you about going to hell when you die, and try and convince you that they can save you from that. If your faith can not withstand logic, you've got the wrong faith.

What is truth? To answer that question, I referred to my Webster dictionary again and it gave me three definitions: (1) real state of things; (2) true or accepted statement; (3) agreement with fact or

reality. I have trouble with Webster's second definition, true or accepted statement, although I understand what he means. After giving Webster's answers a critical analysis and finding it a little shaky, my next question would be; "how do we know truth"? Webster couldn't help me on that one and I had to go at it on my own. Truth is that which can be defined by logic. And if I got that wrong, I've got a lot of things wrong, but if I got it right, then I am one heavy dude because I have used that as the hypothesis to find the answer to much of that which I hold to be true.

The word "truth" is nearly synonymous with the word "knowledge", and the purpose for our existence is to seek them out. Truth and knowledge are endless and the more we learn, the more we will realize how much more there is to learn and the closer we will get to the Creator. Truth and knowledge are to the soul what nourishment is to the body, but you can get too much nourishment and become obese, but you can't get too much truth or knowledge. Truth and knowledge lift our spirit, encourage us to go for more, and is a good thing to be hooked on. Unlike knowledge which appeals to our mind, truth appeals to our conscience and our basic instinct of right and wrong- you can accept it or you can reject it but the

Creator has given us the ability to know it when we hear it!

My understanding of Webster's definition of truth is that there are two kinds of truth, accepted truth and factual truth. I think his accepted truth is nothing but a concocted lie, but who am I to argue with Webster and so I will say that there are two truths and I'll call them (a) truth and (the) truth. (A) truth is something that is agreed upon by two or more parties, like the earth is square and the sun rotates around it, or two or more warring parties agree upon a condition to stop fighting. (The) truth is like two plus two equal four; it is universal and is independent of any agreement. (The) truth is a permanent truth which never changes or conflicts with other universal truths. (A) truth is a temporary and sometimes necessary truth that conflicts with other truths. For example: when they concluded that the earth was square and the sun rotates around it, they used concocted logic and came up with (a) truth because that was the best they could come up with at the time. When (the) truth came along, the ruling establishment was bitterly opposed to it to the extent that they even persecuted poor Galileo until his death.

(A) truth is a matter of opinion, and (the) truth is a matter of fact. Everyone can have their own opinion but they can't have their own fact. This

civilization is built on (a) truth. Religions are the foundation upon which this civilization is built, and all Religion is founded upon (a) truth. Religion has served its purpose and its time has come to an end. It is time for (the) truth. Religion has been the source of many wars and conflicts and as the world gets smaller due to the advancement of communication and travel, that situation is bound to worsen.

Religions were made by man and that which is made by man will fade away with time but God endures forever, and he is on the side of (the) truth. We must choose sides between (a) truth and (the) truth. God the Creator has let (a) truth rule the world for a time and if you look around, you can see that that time is near an end. He has chosen us, the African-Americans, to usher in the new world built upon (the) truth, and through (the) truth he will build his kingdom here on earth.

Our world consists of two parts, the material world and the spiritual world. Our material world, our possessions, can be seen with our naked eyes but our spiritual world, which is just as important, can't be seen with the naked eyes. When we look around the world and see all the progress that has been made through science and technology, you can't help but be impressed. But when we look around the world and see all the fighting and turmoil, that means

something is terribly wrong with our spiritual world. Why is it that our spiritual world lags so far behind our material world? The answer is so simple that you would probably never guess it. “The answer is mathematics; if it weren’t for mathematics, we would probably be living in caves”. Mathematics is universal. All math is relative and never contradicts itself, the same is true with truth. Can you imagine how messed up the world would be if every country had its own version of math? The faith of Truth is to our spiritual world as mathematic is to our material world, and it is just as universal as mathematics.

(The) truth and (a) truth cannot co-exist because they are like darkness and light; when light appears darkness disappears. The only way to not see the light is to close your eyes, and then you will remain in the dark. The same with (the) truth, the only way you cannot know (the) truth is to close your mind and harden your heart. Know for a certainty, God the Creator is on the side of (the) truth! Truth is the foundation upon which the new world is founded, and the belief in God the Creator as the one and only God is the fundamental truth that all other truths are based upon. Once you have accepted this fundamental truth, then you will have taken your first step into the new world.

GOD AND RELIGION

On the question of “is there a God”, people are divided into three categories. An atheist is a person who does not believe that there is a God. An agnostic is a person who believes that the question of whether there is a God or not is unknowable. And the believers, they are the people who believe that God exists. There are two kinds of believers: religious believers, and the non-religious believers, such as myself, whom I think of as true believers. The religious believers believe the way to serve God is to follow their religious teachings. I believe the way to serve God is to do right, and the true knowledge of God is logical and simple. The use of rational logic is the only way there could ever be a global consensus on the subject and the faith of Truth is the only faith that adheres to that.

There are probably more non-religious believers in the world today than there are religious believers. I believe that most of the people of China and throughout the earth are non-religious believers. They do not come out and talk about their simple faith mostly for fear of being ridiculed by the religious establishments. The religious establishments have had a monopoly on the way we should serve God for thousands of years and they

won't go away quietly. I don't believe you serve God through words and emotions. I believe you serve God through your deeds. God is independent of religion and is on the side of truth.

My belief that there is a God is based on simple mathematics, zero from zero leaves zero, or putting it in plain words, nothing comes from nothing. The universe is something and it had to come from something. And whatever that something is, regardless of shape, form, or fashion, is the Creator and the only true and living God. Some scholars claim that the universe was created by a big bang. Then, if that is true and the big bang created itself, then the big bang is God. But there is some supernatural intelligent force governing the universe and we are part of the universe. Many religious believers hold many different beliefs about God, and these differences in beliefs have been the source of many wars and conflicts. They all agree that God represents that which is good. But with their fuzzy logic that they derive from (a) truth, they can't agree on what is good, and this is where the conflicts come in.

One thing all religions have in common, they all think that they are God's true religion. Looking at all the enlightenment that has spread throughout the world over the last thousand plus years, it seems they

haven't learned anything. With the rapid advancement of civilization, this flaw could render them obsolete and antiquated. Religion has served man well for a long period of time, especially in the earlier years when people were not as enlightened as they are today. During the time when religions were asserting their global dominance, people thought that the earth was square and the sun rotated around it. However, as the world grows more knowledgeable, and smaller due to modern day technology, there is a need for a new and more comprehensive and cohesive understanding of God; a simple philosophy built on logic in order to be easily understood all over the world. The knowledge of God is just as fundamental to mankind as mathematics, and it is just as logical and simple as mathematics. Our faith in God is where the large majority of us get our moral value of right and wrong. Without morality, we are on the same level as other animals, and capable of doing anything. I strongly disagree with those who believe you can't have faith in God unless you have or believe in religion. If I were asked what is my faith I would say Truth is my faith, I believe in Truth and Truth dictates my belief in God the Creator.

I believe that God has a personal relationship with each of us, and we should not let anyone or

anything come in between that relationship, and religion does just that. When we listen to our religion instead of our conscience we have interference or disconnect from God. I believe that God relates to us through our conscience, and through our conscience he rewards us with peace and happiness or punishes us with agony and turmoil. I do not believe we need a building or special place to go and serve God; we do this by simply being true to our conscience. I believe you do not have to be loud and emotional to communicate with God; he is as near to you as your conscience and you can call on him 24-7 without making a sound. When you pray out aloud you are most likely trying to impress others within hearing distance of how holy you are and that in itself is unholy. I think of the conscience as something like a microchip that the Creator has installed in all intelligent beings throughout the universe, and this is one of the main factors that separates us from lower forms of life. We use our mind to think, but we use our conscience to know right from wrong. To those of you who have been waiting for God to come, do not look to see him with your physical eyes but with your mind's eye. He has been here all of the time but has not revealed himself because we were not ready for the truth, but once we hear the truth we will know the truth and become responsible for our actions.

You may say, “The God you serve has worked for you all this time so why should you change God”? Because the true God, God the Creator, watches over Babies and Fools, but once you have grown up and heard the truth you’re no longer a Baby nor a Fool and you become responsible for your actions.

I believe that we are now living in the end of the world as we know it, and God has chosen us, the African-American people, to usher in a new world. He is revealing himself to us through the word of truth, and he has revealed that truth to me and chosen me as his messenger to deliver that truth to you. If I do that, I will have peace and happiness, but if I don’t, I will have agony and turmoil and the same will apply to you for accepting or rejecting the truth.

God has only one divine law for us to obey, and that is for us to do that which is right, and when we disobey that divine law there is subsequently a negative or unpleasant consequence that apply to us as individuals, groups, or nations. We are now living in the day of reckoning and America must be counted in that number and this is why God has sent me with The Message. In this Day of Judgment God knows that we have been innocent victims throughout this country’s bloody history and is offering us a choice. We can cast our lot with that of the slave master’s offspring or we can cast our lot on the side of Truth

and trust God to be our protector. If we cast our lot on the side of Truth, that don't mean that we are any less citizens of this country, actually that will make us better citizens because the only law that the Faith of Truth has is to obey the laws of the land. .

Muhammad was indeed a man with a mission from God the Creator, whom they call Allah, and God revealed a lot to him but he never revealed himself because it was not time. Muhammad's mission was a time sensitive mission for the people of that era and religion was ok for that time but that era has long passed and now God is revealing himself to us through the word of truth, independent of religion. Many of the teachings of Muhammad do not apply to the world that we live in today. The practice of Jihad for an example, the belief that if you get killed in battle that you will go straight to heaven, may have been ok to embolden the warriors to fight when they only had horses and swords, but now there are nuclear weapons. What sane person would want a country that believes in jihad to have nuclear weapons?

I believe that the acceptance of God the Creator as the one and only God and to acknowledge that he has no associates and the acceptance of the truth that he represents is the only solution to the multitude of problems we have in our Black communities

throughout this land. We cannot find solutions to these problems in the present world because it's time has come to an end and there is nothing no one can do to save it. But when you accept God the Creator as the one and only God, you have turn your head around strait and taken your first step into the new world. A whole new horizon will begin coming in to view and you will begin seeing and understanding things differently.

Because I have been a Christian and a Muslim, I have a general knowledge of both the Bible and the Quran. Both books have much good in them, and I use anything good I read in any book although I might disagree with the greater portion of the book. Although the religious believers say the books are the words of God, I wouldn't recommend them for reference because they have been tampered with and can be very confusing. I can't say that these books weren't written by men inspired by God, but they have been tampered with, and when you mix truth with lies or vice versa, the result is more treacherous lies, so be the Bible. The Old Testament was supposed to be a book of prophecy, things that will happen at a later date. I must admit, the story about the Israelites in the book of Exodus bears a striking resemblance to our, the African-American people's, plight here in America. The Historians say that the

Egyptians are known to be the world's best keeper of records, and they say that they don't even have a trace of any kind of record of the Jews ever being enslaved in Egypt. It makes you wonder; could the Jews have stolen the script [scripture] to the role that we were to play at a later date. I believe so because we are the only people who have undeniably played the major role of that script [scripture], four hundred years of slavery, and it seems that the stage is being set for us to play the final role. The Jews manipulated the scripture from being a prophecy into being a false documental history and assigned themselves to being God's chosen people. I believe they've already been punished dearly for their transgressions and the worst might be yet to come, but we won't dwell on that, we'll just deal with what lies before us and whatever was meant to be will be.

I have surmised two resolves about the Bible. I am not out to destroy anyone's faith just for the heck of it but to show them a better path. A path that will withstand the rigorous test of logic and rationalization and lead you to a state of prosperity and happiness in this life and the next, if there is a next. If we accepted the Faith of Truth we would unite and learn to do for ourselves instead of depending on other for our livelihood, because that is the right thing to do, and God would bless us if we were as faithful to our newly found faith as we had been to our old one.

What is life? Life is a gift of time given to us by our Creator, but it is left up to us how we spend this time. You can take a negative view of life by dwelling on the fact that someday your life must

come to an end or you can take a positive view of life by being thankful for the time that you have been given and try to make the most of it. To dwell on your demise is bound to leave you in a funk, but if you think about how fortunate you are to be alive it will lift your spirit. Most Religions thrive on the teaching of life after death as a scare tactic and nobody could ever come up with a better scare tactic than that. Nearly everyone who believes in and practices Religion is a victim of this scare tactic and is afraid to open up their minds to the truth regardless of how plain and simple it might be. If you are a victim of this scare tactic, then you are serving the God of the dead, a false God that promises you everything after you die, regardless of what name you might bestow upon him. There is only one true and living God and he is the God of the living and creator of the universe regardless to what name of endearment you might be store upon him. We should stand strong behind the God of the living and let his truth be our guide, for his truth is the light. We should not give into the scare tactics of the Gods of the dead who would lead you deeper into the pit of darkness with lies and deception and farther away from the light of truth. The fear (awareness) of God is the greatest attribute a person can possess because it conquers all other fears and compels you to do that which is right and that'll make you a better person. This is a positive way of starting your day off right, and is a good habit to have. You might say no one is here and no one will be looking so why should I make my bed up. The most important person in the world to you is looking, you. To not make-up your bed because nobody is looking would be to disrespect yourself and lower your self-esteem. What you think of yourself should mean more to you than what other think of you. Remember, the Creator is always looking and we can't shake him. If we get in the habit of keeping a clean surrounding, we would feel better about ourselves. The other eleven are Rational, Courteous, Duteous, Punctual, Patient, Prudent, Courageous, Trustworthy, Grateful, Perseverance, and Versatile. If you practice these twelve attributes you will have made a good start in the right direction and I am inviting you to come and join me in teaching others the right direction.

CULTURE AND RACE

Culture much more so than race makes us who we are. You can take an infant from any race and place him or her in any culture to be raised and he or she would grow up talking and acting like the other people of that culture. The only difference would be in physical features. Different races have different features, but we, the African-American people, are not a biological race. Ninety-nine point nine percent of us are mixed to some degree with some other race, mostly Native American Indians and European Caucasians. But for historic and social reasons, it is important that we identify ourselves as black. Otherwise the racist will try and divide us into a caste system or something. There was no danger of this many years ago, because white men who had children by black women had nothing to do with the raising of the child. In slavery times the child was enslaved right along with the rest of the blacks.

I believe the Caucasian race was put on this earth to help humanity by expediting the advancement of technology and for that they were given dominion over the earth for a time and that time has ended. You can't deny that they have been successful in

their calling but it has come at the expense of all other Races. Racism has been their creed in carrying out their mission but it has no place in the new world that is now emerging and Truth shall prevail. In the past the Caucasians have referred to themselves as being white and all other Races as people of color, and in doing so they declared themselves to be superior. This creed has served them well in the past, but it is like sand in a sand glass, and once the sand runs out and the glass is flipped over they could find themselves in a precarious position.

In the South, white women were seducing black men into having sex with them, but they were not having black babies. If they became pregnant they cried rape and the black man was quickly strung up and hung, but nowadays more white women are having black babies and raising them, and this throws a whole new picture into the light. In most cases these kids are raised in a white culture and at some point in their early life they must come to terms with their black heritage. Usually the kids grow up to be a normal bi-culture African-American. But occasionally they get lost in the woods, and have to find out the hard way that there are tigers in the woods. There are many bi-cultural African-Americans where both parents are black. They become bi-cultural by close encounters with white

kids at an early age, mostly in school or neighborhoods. Being bi-cultural is a great asset to blacks, it enables us to navigate both societies more comfortably. But all African-Americans should vehemently reject the term bi-racial. This is creating a division in our ranks that we definitely don't need. We have had light skinned people in our ranks since the beginning of slavery, and we know they didn't come from Africa that way.

On that topic, I do remember writing a letter to a Chicago Sun-Times columnist, the late Sidney J Harris, about an article he had written on this subject. Mr. Harris wrote interesting articles, I considered myself one of his fans, and had bought his book titled, *The Best of Sidney J Harris*. I hadn't ever seen Mr. Harris write on race or any other sensitive issues until he wrote an article pondering the question of why do Black American refer to themselves as Black when the majority of them are not Black. I got very angry and frustrated over his thinking and started to write a response back, but didn't. About two or three weeks later he wrote another article expressing his surprise at receiving so many negative responses from the Black community about his previous article. After reading the second article on the subject I decided I would respond. To the best of my recollection, I wrote the following letter:

Mr. Sidney J Harris:

I had considered myself to be one of your fans; I even bought your book, THE BEST OF SIDNEY J HARRIS. When I read your article a few weeks ago about why Black Americans shouldn't call themselves Black, I felt ashamed over the hurt I felt. I started to write you then, but I just got frustrated and tore your book asunder. I was somewhat relieved to hear that you got a large negative response from the Black community. Now that that subject has arisen again I would like to argue my view. Compare your color with a white shirt and you would see my point. But if I call you pale, or compare your complexion with that of a plucked chicken, you would be insulted, and rightfully so. Before the Sixties, to be called Black was more insulting than to be call the (N) word. But we took the word Black and made it a word to be proud of. As for our true complexion, we are just as Black as you are White.

Later I received a letter from him saying; Mr. Cole I received your letter and thank you for taking the time to write. However, because of the large volume of letters we receive daily, we are unable to reply to all of them. But be assured, your letter is being giving my closest consideration.

Being a biological multi-racial or race-less person has many pluses. One plus is that the strongest genes from each race are transferred to the multi-racial person. I am not saying that this make a multi-racial person a super person, but having a larger gene pool it seems would increase rather than decrease one's advantage of being a better all-around person. While I was watching a TV educational program, they had a guest on that did scientific research on animals. A caller called in and asked her what was the most intelligent animal in the world and the researcher quickly replied, "a dog" and she went on to say, "I am sorry to all your pedigree owners out there, but this was a mutt."

A mutt is a mixed-breed dog. We should be proud of whom we are, and keep calling ourselves Black or African-American as long as the European Americans call themselves White. If we don't, we will be giving ammunition to the racist among them

to further divide us. In my search for our identity I

have concluded that we are a new and unique people with the most diverse gene pool than any other ethnicity on earth and that is a good thing.

Does African-Americans have a language, if so, who gave it to them? Yes, we have a language and we don't have to be given everything, some things come naturally. Our Mother's tongue is our language and it was passed down to us from our mother. Our language is called bad English by white Americans. Yet the British people say that white Americans speak bad English too, and this has not stopped them from sending a man to the moon. If you want to get ahead in this man's world, it would be wise to learn his language well, but don't kick your own language to the curb because one day you might want to use it for something positive. I think we should strive to be a bilingual people, our language and the white folk's language, but know when to speak which one. I am sure some of you will take issue with my suggestion but I think it is unrealistic to think that we can get the majority of African-Americans to speak the White folk mother's tongue, or so-call "good" English. We might as well accept the fact that our language isn't going nowhere and start using it for something more than just comedy scripts.

I think it is a mistake to try and judge an African-American's intelligent by how well he or she

speaks English. We have too much talent out there being held back because they don't speak so-called good English. I would estimate that only twenty-five percent of us speak so-called good English and I consider myself among the other seventy-five percent. Rather than let all that talent go to waste just because they can't speak the white folk mother's tongue, we should start cultivating our own culture and harvest as much of it as we can.

We should not change our names or wear garments from other cultures, trying to latch on to a historical past. As far as the world communities are concerned we have a clean slate. We should appreciate that and start building our own ideology on a sound foundation anchored in truth so that it will withstand the rigor of time. We should learn from those nations who in the past, built on religious belief and all the misconceptions that go along with it. Their foundations have been badly eroded by the enlightenment that comes with the passing of time and they are now in a moral meltdown. Although we are American citizens, God and the rest of the world communities do not hold us responsible for any of the negative history of this country, and we're not. That is because we and our African ancestors were victims of much of that negative history. We continue to be victimized even today, although to a

lesser degree. It is not in human nature to settle for less than total equality with his counterpart. I am glad to be an American, and would rather be here than in any other nation in the world. But we, the African-American people, should not be content with inequality to any degree. If equality seems unattainable we should contemplate a plan B within the laws of the land, there is much that can and need to be done.

The US has three major cultures, the European (Whites), the African-American (Blacks), and the Hispanics (Brown). The Whites and Blacks both have their demons to overcome and one can't help the other. Racism is the White's demon, and the yoke of slavery, (slavery mentality), is the Black's demon. Racism has been passed down through the White generations since the beginning of nationalism in Europe to such a degree that it is now second nature to them just as slavery mentality is second nature to us.

When the Blacks were emancipated from slavery during the civil war, there was no kind of counseling, teaching, or anything to deal with the mental trauma of four hundred years of slavery and left them with a slave mentality that has been passed down to us through the generations. This mentality is our biggest demon and nothing short of a cultural

revolution can defeat it. It has affected all of us, even yours truly, and the ones who think that they are not affected are in deep denial and are worse off than the ones who admit it. When they enslaved us, they didn't just enslave our bodies, they enslaved our minds also. When they freed our bodies from bondage, they didn't free our minds. Anyone who believes false doctrine to be truth and truth to be false doctrine has their head on backward. Until we recognize and address this fact, our minds will continue to be in bondage, and it is the mind that controls the body. The first step in solving any problem is recognizing the problem. Only until we admit and address the problem, will we become free and begin seeing the world through our own eyes. I think that part in the bible that says, when you hear the truth you shall know the truth, and the truth shall set you free, might apply here. Only then can we begin to love ourselves and one another and unite as a free people. Once we do this we can do anything we set our minds too. We should not feel bad or blame ourselves for this mentality because it was forced upon our ancestors during slavery and we just naturally inherit it through the generations. But knowing that we have this demon is the first step toward defeating it. For example; if you are in the presence of Whites, you would probably feel the urge

to say or do something clever to impress them; that's like a dog wagging his tale in the presence of his master- that is the demon at work.

The nature of the demon is such that it makes us hate ourselves and kind and love and admire the offsprings of those who enslaved our fore parents. The rest of the world looks at us in wonderment, like we got our heads on backward or something. But if they knew what got us this way, they would understand. The institution of slavery in the United State was like nothing ever been tried before in history. It was difficult to enslave people who had a free mind, and so they set out to create a people with a slave mind. And they succeeded, and they call these new slave people Negroes. They took the Blacks from Africa and shipped them to the Caribbean Islands where they were enslaved and used as breeding stock. They would take their babies and bring them to the United States to be raised as slaves. The child grew up not knowing one word of his Mother's native tongue. All he or she knew is what the white slave master taught him or her. If you have ever wondered why all the other Blacks around the world talk with an African accent and we're the only ones that don't, that is the reason why. The child grew up seeing the world and himself through the slave master's eyes. And that is why some of us use the N word and have

such a low esteem of ourselves and kind. There are many negative fall-outs from slavery, but being totally dependent on the slave master's off-springs is probably the worse. It's not that we can't do the same things that they are doing; we do it for them every day. But due to our slave mentality we will not do it for ourselves. If we could break this yoke we would be a successful people, and I believe we can and will do that.

I believe that God the Creator has brought us, the African-American people, to this place and juncture to prove to the rest of the world that he and he alone is God. I believe he is going to take us, the descendant of slaves, and make us the cornerstone of humanity. What race can represent the human race better than a people that are not a race but a (multi-racial)?

The first step in solving a problem is recognizing that you have a problem. Our concept of the problem is "everybody got that problem except me". Before we can solve the problem, we will have to come out of denial and recognize that we all have the same problem. In other words, the same snake that bit you bit me, and the same antidote that will heal me will heal you also. We should not feel shame or look down on ourselves for being this way, anyone who went through what we went through would probably

have been worse off than we are. We must remember the problem did not occur overnight and it will not be fixed overnight. Once we recognize it, we can keep it under control so that we can manage it and work around it. It's like a drug or alcohol addiction that you are trying to get rid of. You might not ever use it again but you can never get rid of it because it is implanted in your brain. It would take at least another generation before we can get rid of it. Once we start recognizing it and talking about it amongst ourselves, then we are on our way to something good. They didn't know what they were doing when they instituted that type of slavery; it hadn't ever been tried before. What they did was to create a new people with no history, and with the same value and aspiration as them. All we have to do is get our heads on straight and enter into our own renaissance of a sort.

The White race has the same but different problem. Just as we have been nourished through the past generations to have a slave mentality, they have been nourished through the generations to have a racist mentality. Just as we can recognize our problem and work around it, they can recognize their problem and work around it- and some do. Racism is not in the genes of people of any race, but in the culture; and nearly all Whites in the USA are born

into that culture. Although some might try and rise above it, you never know when they might fall off the wagon. Racism and slavery mentality is so well woven into the fabric of our respective culture that it has become like a disease; it lies dormant and attacks our psyche at an early age.

Only the African-Americans whose mothers were not a descendant of slavery in the United States are not affected by the yoke of slavery mentality. When they come here from the Caribbean Islands or Africa, they tend to out achieve us. To name a few; Marcus Garvey, Harry Belafonte, Sydney Portiere, Malcolm X, Louis Farrakhan, Colin Powell, Tiger Woods, and you can put president Barack Obama in that category, his mother was not a descendant of slavery. There are a growing number of African-American children being raised by White Mothers. Although they won't have the yoke problem, at some point they will have to come to terms with who they are, and we should welcome them in our folds with open arms.

I believe that the Creator has destined us, the African-American people, to be the next standard bearer of humanity. I don't think it will happen in some sort of mysterious way, I think the process will be very natural. If you follow the helm of civilization, or standard bearers of civilization, all the way back to ancient Egypt up to modern day

America, you will see a pattern of close relationship or some sort of intercourse with the previous standard bearer and the new one. We definitely meet those criteria. It is sort of like the new standard bearer is right there to act as a back-up when the old one goes into default or something. But to make that transition we must believe and rely on the Creator and acknowledge that there is no God but him, and he has no associates, because we cannot make this transition alone. And we seek his help by employing our minds in which he has given us to think with and not our emotions which we have mistakenly relied on in our relationship to God in the past. A little poem I created: “Do your best and God will do the rest, although you might think that you have given your all and passed the test, but in the end it is he who knows best.” If we had relied on our minds in relation to God like we have relied on our emotions, we would probably be one of the most prosperous people on earth.

We must lay a solid foundation for a new world and the belief in one God should be that foundation. A world, or society, is made up of thoughts and ideas, and the material things we see in that world are products of those thoughts and ideas. The world that we now live in is made up mostly of greed. That is why such a small group of people control nearly all

of the wealth, while so many people go needy. It will remain that way as long as a large majority of the general population believes material wealth is the only thing that matters. Such thinking is bound to produce a dog eat dog society with corruption being the norm. In trying to build our new world we should observe the old world closely and try to learn and use that which is good and avoid that which is bad. People are social creatures by nature; they tend to follow one another like a flock of birds. If in the beginning we could stress the appreciation of a plenty, and the virtue of character building, that would be a good start and hopefully others would follow.

Class is mostly in the eyes of the beholder, but it does play a significant role in our modern day society. Because of the social nature of the human race, we are very conscious of how others perceive us. To a large degree it is our perception of things that determine its value. For example, diamonds and gold are two of our most expensive items, but what is it good for, you can't eat it, you can't ride it, you can wear it but it won't keep you warm. The only real value it has is it makes people perceive us to be in a higher class, and if people perception change, so will the value of the items. As long as we perceive personal possession to be the only thing to determine

class status we will continue to fuel the greed that has corrupted this society and divided us into have and have not. I realize that people have different desires, but speaking for myself, I believe that there is such a thing as a plenty, and to want more seems greedy.

THE UNIVERSE

Science and religion do not mix, but science and God the Creator are inseparable and we were put here to study the creation and this will bring us closer to the Creator. They are more intelligent than we are and that is why they do us no harm. If we could get to them, we would probably try to wipe them out. This tells us that the more intelligent beings are closer to the Creator than the less intelligent ones, and we

need

not fear them. They've probably been somewhere in the universe billions of years, and we, the human race, are new comers. I believe that at some point in time, before the earth becomes uninhabitable, we, the human race, will have evolved into something like them and live in outer space also. I believe that we belong to a group of intelligent beings that live in space throughout the universe, and we are in an early stage of evolving. When we think of time in the universe, our civilization has only been around for a blink of an eye.

How did we get here? That is the question that we have pondered for many centuries. I theorize that we were planted here by so called aliens and have evolved into what we are today. And we will continue to evolve until we look something like the so called aliens that planted us here. I think they no longer have sex and this is their way of reproduction. Being nose-y is human nature but sometimes we overdo it and get ourselves in trouble. Enlightenment lifts our spirit, the more we know about the creation the more we will know about the Creator. Knowledge is one thing we can't get too much of. The more we learn, the more we realize how much we don't know. The more we learn the closer we will get to our ultimate goal- eternal life. I believe that the so called extraterrestrial beings have already reached that goal and their bodies do not deteriorate from age. They are probably millions of years old. When we reach eternal life we will be in heaven, but we will have to go through hell to get to heaven.

SEXUALITY

I believe that homosexuality is not normal, but is an abnormality, and as such, should not be promulgated or accepted as the norm. But a person should not be persecuted or ridiculed for their abnormality as we have done in the past. Sexuality is a sensitive subject that many, if not all, good authors have avoided writing on, and wisely so. The conventional meaning for the word sexuality refers only to male and female, but for the lack of a better word, I am stretching it to include all sexes, heterosexual, homosexual, and bi-sexual. To start off with, despite what some of my co-workers may think, I am heterosexual and have never in my life had any kind of homosexual experience, and I am writing this topic from a heterosexual point of view. It's not the size of a man's penis or how muscular a woman is that make them gay, I believe it is something else going on inside their heads. It might have something to do with the human race's continued evolution. We may be evolving into some kind of neutral sex or something. There seems to be many more homosexuals today than there were fifty years ago. I think the biggest problem that exists among all sexes is a law that is never enforced, the right to privacy. It is against the law for someone to display their private parts in public, but it happens all the time in public locker rooms and washrooms throughout the nation. Those facilities provide inadequate and most time no partition to assure the privacy that most people want, and deserve to stay within the law. It's not a matter of some small penis heterosexual being stared at by some large penis homosexual, or the other way around, in the locker room. It's a matter of basic privacy being taken away from the general public by those businesses just to save a little money. They will continue to do this as

long as the general public does not complain. They know that most people are reluctant to raise this issue.

On the issue of same sex marriage, I believe that the one standard marriage fits all is antiquated and needs to be updated on the federal level. I believe that there should be one standard for a normal marriage and it should be between the opposite sex only. I also believe that it should be a contractual marriage between any sex, same or opposite.

What is the most valuable thing in the world? Human life! Do I win that argument or need I say more? The main purpose of a marriage is to produce this priceless gem and without it the human race will cease to exist. This gem can only be produced between a male and a female. The question is should society look upon a marriage that cannot produce this gem as being the same or equal to a marriage that can. My answer to that question is an emphatic no! It is preposterous to view the two marriages as having the same merit when one produces' life that sustains humanity and one doesn't. Even to compare a homosexual marriage, for the conveniences of two people, to a heterosexual marriage, for the proliferation of humanity, is degrading to the institution of heterosexual marriage and there should be a clear and distinct observance between the two.

Because of past prejudices and injustice towards the Gay community, we, the heterosexuals, tend to overreact on their behalf because of guilt and fear of being labeled a homophobic. The gay community is intelligent and is quick to pick up on this and push their agenda to the max, using the H word as their secret weapon and won't hesitate to zap you with it.

I compare being homosexual to being a left handed person. It is not normal, but no one should be punished for it. It is plain ludicrous that we show more mercy toward our pet animals by having them euthanized when they are terminally ill, than we do toward our love ones by not permitting them to do the same. If anything, it seems like it would be the other way around; let the animal die a slow and agonizing death and show mercy towards the loved one. History will remember Dr. Kevorkian as it did Galileo, as an unsung hero ahead of his time.

A SNAP SHOT OF HISTORY

Knowledge of the past helps us better understand what's going on in the present, and give us a better foresight of the future, and that is why I am writing this chapter. I didn't get interested in history until after I dropped out of high school. I started thinking about different things related to history, and it dawned on me that I could find some answers in the history books. I hit the library and book stores, and I developed a passion for history. I didn't study history to get good grades; I studied history because I had a desire to know. I also learned that you have to study history with an open mind because sometimes it can be slanted or things omitted or added in for some other purpose. That is what I call indoctrinated history. Often times the historians will write different accounts on events that occurred in history. What I find most interesting about history is how everything is related from the beginning of civilization right up to the present. I find it interesting to trace the helm of Western civilization from its beginning in ancient Egypt to its present place, the United States of America. It moved from Egypt to Persia, to Greece, to Rome to Great Britain, and after the Second World War, to the USA. It looks like no one or nothing could have set this course

except the Creator. I believe we have come to this critical point in time that we must choose sides between good or evil, right or wrong, and truth or lies. I believe that the Creator has set the stage and is going to prove that he, she, or it is still around, and didn't just make a big bang and left the scene, like most atheists believe. To better understand how we, the African-Americans, (so called black), fit into the present time and what might be our destiny, I will have to go back about 2015 years ago, or around the beginning of our current calendar. This was during the time when the Romans had just defeated the Greeks and became the number one empire in the world.

Peter, sometime referred to as Paul, or Saul, was a Jew that lived in Greece and belonged to the Jewish highest echelon. Because he was not Greek, he found favors from the conquering Romans, and would sometime run errands for the conquerors. The Greeks were known for their Mythology, and Peter used much of it to create a new religion. One day when Peter was running an errand on his donkey a very bright idea came to him. Some writers say it knocked him off his donkey. But whatever it was, it inspired him to write the New Testament, and this was the beginning of the religion of Christianity.

After about two hundred years the Roman Emperor Constantine had converted to Christianity and Christianity spread throughout Europe. The introduction of Christianity into Europe sent Europe into, what they call, the Dark Age. People started believing in ghosts, vampires, witches, werewolves, and all sorts of superstitious things. Nearly all the knowledge that the Romans had gotten from Greece was lost and they didn't pursue education. All of Europe seemed to have been going backwards. Sometime around the 9th century, Christianity was divided into two camps, the Eastern (Greek) and the Western (Latin). They would later be known by what they are called today, the Greek Orthodox Church and the Roman Catholic Church. The capitol for the Eastern Orthodox Church was in Constantinople, now Istanbul Turkey and the Western Roman Catholic had their capitol in Rome.

In the seventh century a new religion called Islam came on the scene led by a fearless leader they called Prophet Muhammad. Muhammad was spreading his religion with the sword. By the 11th century the Muslims had pushed deep into Europe and had overrun the Orthodox Christian capitol in the East. The Pope in the East asked the Pope in the West to send help. This was the beginning of the crusades; the Pope in Rome sent out word that

Christianity was being attacked by infidels and for every able-bodied person to come to the defense of their religion. They were still in the Dark Age and the only thing they had was their religion, and they came from all over Europe. When they gathered in Rome, they had a hard time communicating because they were speaking so many different dialects. At the time there was no official language in Western Europe, and nearly every village had its own dialect. Some were on horseback but most of them were on foot. They were unprepared for war but they had numbers going for them.

For nearly the next two-hundred years they would have seven more crusades and two botched crusades that never made it out of Europe. They won a few battles but lost most of them to the more culturally advanced Muslim Army. Asia had not suffered from the Dark Age like Europe had. Their building structure, education system, and culture in general were much more superior to the Europeans. The crusaders might have lost the most battles but they gained a lot from their experience. When they arrived in the East they were awed by what they saw. Some mingled with the Muslims and were taught new things, such as the numbers that we use in science and math today. Before this, they were using Roman numbers that were awkward and complicated.

When the crusaders would return from their excursions in the East, they would sit around for a while and think about all the nice things they had seen in the East, and they would try to imitate it. They were filled with new ideas and aspirations. These new ideas and aspirations spread across Europe bringing about a period they called the Renaissance, (meaning enlightenment).

The biggest achievement of the crusades was to ushered in the Renaissance. Historians generally mark the period of the Renaissance from shortly before the end of the 13th century to about the 1600's, but actually it is still going on throughout the world. Perhaps they do this because the 1600's, with the coming of King James, marked the end of Medieval (middle age) and the beginning of the modern age, in which we live today. During the Renaissance people began experimenting with new ideas and inventing things. They began to open their minds and question some of their religious beliefs that were built around the Pope and the Catholic Church. This thinking led to the Protestant (protesting) movement. People began preaching their versions of Christianity in the streets of England or wherever they could get someone to listen. From this many different denominations of Christianity were born and most are still practiced today.

At the beginning of the 16th century, nearly all of England was Protestant. Most of the Protestants were people who just left the Catholic Church without causing a disturbance in the Church itself. But on October, 31st, 1517, a German Priest and professor of theology by the name of Martin Luther, who also was an Augustinian Monk, nailed his 95 Thesis of Contentions to the door of the Castle Church, and all hell broke loose. Most historians use that date to mark the beginning of the Reformation period.

The Reformation period was when there were wars and turmoil going on between the Catholic Church and the Protestant. Martin Luther translated the New Testament from the Greek-Latin language into a German Language, or a language that the German people could understand. He later retranslated the New Testament and the Old Testament into a German language that is somewhat of a model for Modern day Germany. Martin Luther was looked upon as a hero by all the Protestants throughout Europe.

King James reigned during the cross over from medieval to modern time, and he was the key figure in that transition, racism and all. King James was the grandson of the notorious wife abuser, King Henry 8th of England. Elizabeth and Mary were King Henry 8th's daughters by two different wives. Sometime

after his death, they both tried to maneuver to become the queen of England. After Queen Elizabeth had won the struggle, she decided to eliminate the competition once and for all. She had her sister, King James's mother, Mary of Scot, beheaded or burned at the stake, according to which historian you want to believe. Every account I've read says the young King James, in his late teens, stood watching his mother's execution without showing any emotion. After the execution he went to England to live with his Aunt, Queen Elizabeth, who had just had his mother executed. Queen Elizabeth didn't have any heir apparent and the young King James had his eyes on the throne of England.

I find all history interesting, but the history of Britain's King James, I find intriguing, deceptive, and interesting. He was somewhat of an evil genius, and is the chief architect of the English language we speak today. At first glance you would wonder why this king isn't more heard of than other kings who have had little or no impact on history. But if you use an open mind and dig a little deeper, you can better understand why European historians do not write more about King James. I feel that we, the African-Americans people, should have a clearer knowledge of King James's history because he is probably the most responsible person for our plight

today, “by initiating slavery of our fore parents.” He should be label the finding father of Western Civilization. He had more to do with the English language and the bible than any other person.

I believe this was a prime example of indoctrinated history. I believe King James and William Shakespeare was the same person. The historians of the time did such a good job at concealing this until they out did themselves. The smoking gun is how could two of the most popular figures of their time, who lived in the same general vicinity, at the same time “have no written history of them ever crossing paths”? I’ve read about how much Queen Elizabeth liked to sit in the balcony of the palace theater and watch Shakespeare perform, but never once have they mentioned King James and Shakespeare in the same text, that omission is like an 800 pound gorilla being in the room. According to historians, King James lived from (1566-1625) and Shakespeare from (1564-1616). King James did not take the crown of England until after the death of Queen Elizabeth 1 in 1603. And what had he been doing all those 37 years before becoming king? Although he became king of Scotland shortly after his birth, you never read anything about him ruling Scotland until he became king of England. I believe he had been writing and performing under the

pseudonym of Williams Shakespeare and possibly under disguise. You might wonder why he would be writing and performing under an assumed name and not his own. According to what I have read about the thinking of that time, it was looked down upon for a nobleman, let alone a royal, to do the things Shakespeare was doing. These were the type of things that were left for the servant and commons to do.

Historian writes that when King James translated the Bible, he gathered all the great writers of that time to help him...excluding Shakespeare. Seems that Shakespeare, being the greatest writer of that time, would have been the first to be called on. Yet, in written history there is no mention of the two paths ever crossing in the same text. The Bible is the foundations of the English language and is the first book ever written in English. Before Shakespeare, King James or whoever translated the Bible from Latin into English, there was no official English language, and they were making up the official English languish as they translated. If you ever wondered why Shakespeare's writing is so similar to that in the Bible, it could be because he translated the Bible.

At some point during this era, the Europeans got their hands on some gun powder, and the world

hasn't been the same since. The Chinese had invented gun powder hundreds of years earlier and only used it for celebrations or peaceful purposes. But when it got in the hands of the white men, they set out to conquer the world, and they did for a while. Some of the major countries of Europe called a meeting and agreed to divide the rest of the world of people of color among themselves by colonizing them. In order to justify this they called themselves "white", which they are not, and the rest of the world, people of color. They declared themselves superior to people of color and depended on the newly acquired gun powder to supply the might to make right. Might did make right for many years and this only enforced the belief among them that whites were superior to non-whites. This belief has been so embedded in them over the last five hundred years or so until nearly all of them have a racist mentality. Although they all are in denial but some of them are not racist, some are able to recognize and work around this problem, racism is not in the genes it is in the culture. My mission is to the African-American people, especially the descendant of Slaves, but whites who are married to blacks and some of their family members or those who have black children will be welcome to join the mission.

MY MISSION

You're probably asking yourself, "If God has a personal relationship with me, why should I become affiliated with any movement or organization of any kind"? The answer is that we are not just individuals who live alone, but we are social beings that live together in a society and we have an obligation to that society, that social obligation is a big part of our personal relationship with God. It is my mission to unite all True Believers under one God.

The dictionary gives two definitions for the word nation; (1) People with similar characteristics; (2) Community with its own territory and government. We, the African-American people, clearly qualify for the first definition, and clearly do not qualify for the second one. This clearly makes us a nation within a nation. Whether we like it or not we must accept this truth before we can move ahead as a people. No matter how successful you become as an individual, the people of the world will always see you as an African-American. When the founding fathers bought us here as slaves, they had no intention for us to be no more than that, and would turn over in their graves if they could see how far we have come. Why should we sing their praises?

Although we are blessed to be in the land of plenty, we don't owe no debts of gratitude to no one except for those who struggled and suffered to get us this far, and to the Creator for looking over us. Whether we realize it or not, it has been God's plan to send us on this long journey

through slavery and suffering to make us the people that we are. And now we are at the most vital junction of our journey. If we take the right path God will be with us, but if we take the wrong path than we are doom. The right path will be laid out in plain truth, and if you reject it, it won't be because you don't know it. That vital junction that we are fast approaching is for us to unite under one God as a nation within a nation. I know some of you probably think that I am some sort of nut for some of my assertions such as us being a nation within a nation, and I would like to clarify my position on that. I am blessed to have plenty and consider myself among the middle class. I have relatively good health for a person my age and I realize I am not getting any younger. I want to get the most out of my remaining years. I am grateful to God for my existence and I will follow the path he has chosen for me to the end. When I am spreading the truth by giving out my books it makes me feel like I am accomplishing something. I believe that people will respond to the message when God get ready for them to, but it is my duty to get it out there. As long as I do that, I can keep enjoying my middle class lifestyle. If that makes me a nut, then so be it. As all of us old time farm boys knows, a yoke is a long wooden device that is tied around cattle necks to keep them from breaking through the fence and running free. We, the African-American people, have a much more sophisticated type of yoke that was place upon us by our slave masters and we will be dependent on them for our livelihood until we can figure it out and break it, and I am about to take a whack at it right now.

It is racism pure and simple, well, not so simple, because it is black racism. When you think of racism you would normally think of one race hating on another race. Well the slave masters dropped a whammy on us and got us hating ourselves and loving them. Please bear with me while I try and explain how this came about.

As I have stated before, it is obvious that the slave masters separated the babies from their African Mothers, because we are the only people on earth who can't speak one word of our native tongue. It is the culture that make's a person who they are much more-so than race, and that black slave child latches on to the only culture that it was exposed to, which was the white slave master's culture with its Black racism and all. It has been passed down through the generations to this very day. When the slave masters freed our bodies from slavery, they did not and could not free our minds; that is the yoke that we must break before we are truly free. Accepting the truth that God has revealed to me will break that yoke and set you free. Until we recognize and address this problem, we will continue to be subservient and dependent on the white race for our livelihood. However, if we recognize and address the problem, then we could solve it. Then we would love ourselves and our kind and strive toward becoming independent of the white race. The first step in solving the problem is to accept the fact that the problem exists, no problem can be solved unless you recognize it. If we are waiting for the slave master's off-spring to show us the problem, "that ain't gonna happen" only the truth will set us free, and God has sent me with that truth. If you accept

it, your mind will be set free, and you will start thinking outside of that psychological box that has held it captive since the beginning of slavery. The yoke will be broken.

I was watching a TV talk show recently when the show host asked a well known Black Preacher, what needed to be done to stop all the violence among the Black youths on the Southside of Chicago. His answer was that they needed to bring more jobs to those communities, (THEY- meaning the white folks). I know I am in the great minority on this, but I found his answer to be appalling. Having more jobs in our community would certainly help ease the problem, but to imply that we expect someone else to create the jobs for us is shameful and exposes the bigger problem that I have forementioned. The time has come for us to start taking responsibility for ourselves and stop relying on others. And the best way to do that is for us to unite as a nation within a nation.

I am an African-American Nationalist in the sense of us uniting under one God and creating some form of government within the laws of the land to address all the problems that plague our communities. Becoming self-sufficient and independent of the white race for our livelihood should be plan A. I don't consider myself a separatist, but if we are successful with plan A and still can't live in peace with the white race, then we should contemplate a plan B. At my age I wouldn't expect to be around to see that happen but God will be with you.

The time has come for God to build his kingdom on Earth and he has chosen us, the descendants of slaves, to usher in the new world and that new world

will be his kingdom and he will make us the corner stone of that kingdom. I know this might sound like a lot of religious hoop-lah but God has a plan and his plan never goes wrong. You might think that his plan went wrong when he let our fore parents be bought here as slaves, but that was a part of a bigger plan, to breed a new people to start a new world and the time has come for us to start on our mission. We will call this mission “The New World Mission of Truth”.

And for the benefit of our fair minded white counterparts we must acknowledge that we recognize that slavery is not the result of anyone living today. Although those who were responsible for slavery have passed on, the result of slavery is very much alive among us and only we can solve it. We would appreciate your patience and understanding.

First we must recognize the fact that the founding fathers had no intention of the Blacks ever having equality in this land, and that’s putting it lightly. Secondly, we must recognize the fact that the majority of whites share their founding father’s mean sprit feeling of white supremacy and racism, and there lies the dilemma; do we accept the role of second class citizens or “do we do something about it”? While it is true that we have made great stride in

getting civil rights laws passed through our struggles of the sixties, we must remember that laws can easily be changed with the stroke of a pen.

Ok Wesley, now are you just trying to scare the hell out of us or what? Yeah, I am trying to scare the hell out of you if that is what it takes to show you that the path that we are on is a dangerous one, and that through God's mercy, he has reveal to me the right path. Out of all the problem we have as a people, our total dependency on the white race is our worst one and should be our first priority. To solve this problem we will have to start somewhere and talking about it is a good place to start, so here I go. I am for creating a government within a government. I know that sounds a bit bold but that's starting from the top. Starting from the bottom, I would first create a large ministry and at the proper time, transform that ministry into a government. I know without me giving all the details about how this could be done, it sounds a little crazy, but if it is God's will we will succeed. And I believe it is God's will, but I'll be watching over my shoulder for the guy wearing the white jacket anyway.

Wesley, how do you intend to get the people to follow you, and how do we know that you're not going to pull one of them Jim Jones things on us if we do? By default, is the plain and simple answer to

the first part of your question. By that, I mean after all else has failed and things continue to get worse and they have no other way to turn, then they will accept the truth and I will be right there with it. And as for the second part of your question, at my age, if it came down to a plan B, relocating, I don't think I will be around, it would have to happen on somebody else's watch. My mission is to unite my people under one God.

If you had wrote this book, my question to you would be, "what qualifications have you got to write on the subject", or "what makes you think you're the man?" Aha, I read your mind; you want to know the same from me. Due to the multitude and perplexity of the African-American problems, if a person had all the education in the world they still couldn't solve them, only God could prepare one to solve them and that is my qualification. How does a homing pigeon find his way back home regardless where you take him? It is because God has prepared him that way and all he has to do is to be himself. In chapter one, I wrote about having been on a long journey, I was referring to seeking answers to the many problems that befall my people. During that journey God prepared me for what lies ahead, all I have to do is to be myself. How do I know that I am

the man for this mission, because God has revealed it to me.

I don't consider myself all that smart, and it would take such a person as me to argue with Mr. Webster and his dictionary. I totally disagree with his definition of the word "wisdom". He defines wisdom as an accumulated knowledge. I define wisdom as an innate ability to acquire the knowledge to achieve ones ends, even if it means employing the knowledge of others, or something like that. I think Webster's definition for wisdom defines a smart person, not a wise person, a machine can be smart. A smart person is made, but a wise person is born, and we need such a person to lead us out of the situation we're in. Am I wise? A wise person would never answer that question but since you have almost finished reading my book, I'll let you be the judge. Am I smart? Not very, but I am smart enough to stay a step ahead of the guy wearing the white jacket. And I am wise enough to know that with the current pace of turmoil going on in the world, the day will soon come that every tub must sit on its own bottom, and we don't even have a tub, let alone a bottom for it to sit on, and that's no joke.

My long journey through the wilderness started on a Thursday night, May 21, 1964, and lasted for forty years or so. It was during the time when I was a

follower of Elijah Muhammad; Malcolm X and Elijah Muhammad were in the middle of a heated split and I, like many others of Elijah's followers, was torn between which one I should follow. It was about 10:00 pm when I returned home from work going door to door cutting hair in the new Robert Taylor Homes. Me and my wife and two kids shared a three bed room apartment with my twin brother and his wife and three kids and everyone was in the bed sleep. I had a nice day and had decided to stay with Elijah and remain in Chicago rather than going to New York and joining Malcolm X. Although my wife had told me she was with me with whatever I decided, I knew if I joined Malcolm it would put a strain on me and my twin brother's relationship, he was firmly behind Elijah. It was a normal night like any other night, after eating I went through the normal ritual of washing up before making the evening prayer. I then got my prayer rug and walked through the dining room and family room into the larger front guest room, where I normally made prayer, rolled out my prayer rug, kicked off my house shoes, stood on the rug, prepared to make prayer. As I stood facing the east with the palms of my hand cuffed by my side, as soon as I bowed my head it seemed like I could feel the presence of someone else enter the room from the way that I was facing. Just

when I was about to raise my head to see who it was, the feeling of the presence of some entity standing right in front of me engulfed me so fast and so strong that I feared if I raised my head I would be looking into the face of God, and with my head still bowed, I started reciting my prayer. As I prayed in silence I could feel tears running down my cheek. After finishing my prayer the strong feeling of someone's presence left, and when I raised my head I was relieved to see that there was nobody standing there. I then rolled up my prayer rug and put it away and went to bed. Without giving much thought about what had just happened, I fell off into a deep sleep. It was the best sleep I can ever remember having.

When I awakened the next morning, I went through my regular routine without telling anyone about what I had experienced. As I moved around that morning I became aware that I was in a state of tranquility that I had never experienced before. It's hard to describe, but it seemed like I was in a state of total peace and my mind was so sharp that it seemed that I was able to pick-up on the thoughts of others. It seemed like people were drawn to me, especially those who had problems, and I would try to say something to make them feel better. It seemed like my mind was in a higher place and nothing could agitate me, and I thought this would last forever.

When I went to work cutting hair that Friday and Saturday everything went well and the little kids that cried and protested getting their hair cut didn't even bother me. That Sunday when I went to the Temple I consoled some Muslim Brothers that were torn between Malcolm X and Elijah Muhammad, and a few of them came over to our apartment later on that evening after the service. When I got up and went to work that Monday morning, I noticed that something was different, those little kids that protested getting their hair cuts a few days ago now seemed to agitate me like they used to before my strange experience. As the day went on, it became clearer to me that I was returning back to my old self, and this frightened me, mainly because I thought I might have to endure the agony of being torn between Malcolm and Elijah again. I hadn't told anyone about what had happened to me, but in a panic to know the meaning of it I did something I knew I wasn't suppose to do, I went to Elijah Muhammad's mansion and rung his door bell.

It was on a Monday evening and I had worn my suit to work so I could leave work and go and attend the FOI meeting that was held every Monday in the auditorium of the Temple at 7:00 pm. As the day went on I became more anxious to know what the meaning of my experience was and decided that I

would take a chance and leave work early and go by my spiritual leader's house and seek some kind of answer, knowing that I could get in trouble. When I rang the bell to the mansion the butler, who was one of Mr. Muhammad's younger cousins by the name of Clarence, came and opened the door and asked me what did I want. I told him that I would like to speak to the Messenger. He asked me did I have an appointment and when I answered no, he said that I couldn't see the Messenger without an appointment. I tried pleading with him as polite as I could but to no avail. So I took my time in walking the six or seven blocks back to the Temple to attend the FOI meeting, knowing that I was probably in big trouble.

When I got back to the Temple, the FOI meeting was already in progress upstairs in the auditorium and after being searched I went and took a seat alone with the hundred and fifty or so other Brothers. And sure enough, it wasn't long before one of the inspectors, Brother Theodore Bey, came and tapped me on the shoulder and said they wanted to see me down stairs. I followed him down stairs and into an empty class room where he ordered me to have a seat as he stood behind the desk waiting for another inspector, Brother Alvar X, to come and join him in interrogating me. It was an uncomfortable seven or eight minute just sitting there looking into that stern

Dick Tracy looking face of Brother Theodore as he stood silently waiting for Brother Alvar. After Brother Alvar arrived and they started interrogating me, I did my best to avoid telling them the real reason I had gone by the Messenger's Mansion, but after seeing I couldn't get around it I took a deep breath and told them the truth. After I had finished explaining to them what had happened, they told me to remain seated while they left the room. They returned shortly afterward and told me that I could go back upstairs. I went back upstairs and took a seat in the rear when after a few minutes Brother Theodore came back and tapped me on the shoulder and told me to follow him. I got up and started following him towards the stairs expecting the worst but when we reached the lobby he turn and told me that they had called and talked to the Messenger and he was waiting to see me and I could leave now. I politely thanked him and tried to conceal my enthusiasm as I headed for the door. Once outside, I ran every step of the way, stopping just long enough to catch my breath before entering the mansion.

When I rang the bell, Brother Clarence opened the door and I told him that I had an appointment to see the Messenger, expecting him to invite me in. When he told me that I couldn't see the Messenger because he wasn't feeling well, I tried to explain to

him that the officials hadn't been long talking to him on the phone and he was waiting for me, but he still refused to let me in. When I left the mansion I was very angry at Brother Clarence for not letting me in and rather than going back to the FOI meeting I took a cab home.

When I went to bed that night, I was so frustrated that I couldn't sleep. I was filled with anxiety to know what this strange experience was all about and why I had not been able to see the Messenger. The only thing that consoled me was to accept the fact that if God wanted me to meet with the Messenger, Brother Clarence would not have been able to prevent it. Now looking back, I can understand that, because I now hold Elijah in low esteem and at the tender age of twenty-five he might have had a negative effect on me.

I remained in the Nation of Islam for three or four more years, but I never tried to meet with Elijah again and began seeing him as he really was, a little man full of greed. I learned much more of what not to do than what to do by observing Elijah. The main thing that kept me in the Nation of Islam was the close camaraderie in the brotherhood of the FOI. We had a high moral standard and weren't supposed to participate in none of the negative things going on in the wilderness of despair all around us. I stayed on

even after the assassination of Malcolm X, although I am not proud of it, but my thinking was that it was better to be in the Nation than to just be another lost soul out there in the wilderness of despair. I took as much as I could take, but after watching so much wrong going on in the higher echelon at the expense of the poor faithful followers for so long, I just couldn't take no more.

In 1968 I decided I would leave the Nation and take my chances in the wilderness of despair right along with the rest of my Black sisters and brothers. I knew that there were many pit-falls in the wilderness and I would need some kind of moral compass so I wouldn't fall victim to them. I embraced a moral code that my mother had instilled into us as we were growing up. As soon as you walked into our house, the first thing you will see is a plaque on the wall with glittering decorative writing that read: "do unto others as you would have them do unto you". I might not agree with everything in the Bible, but that particular verse is one I try to live by even today. That verse might have kept me from misusing other but it didn't keep me from misusing myself. As I made the long journey through the wilderness, I did wade through the mud of drugs and alcohol alongside many more of my sisters and

brothers, and I understand their plight and hope they will come and join me on the right path.

While being lost in the wilderness for forty some years I never stopped searching for the right path that would lead me out. Although I waded through the mud, I was smart enough or blessed enough not to become devoured by it like so many of my sisters and brothers did. Many of them have reached out to religion as a raft to stay afloat, although they've had to close their mind's eye in order to accept a lot of the religious dogma; it is a better path for them than the one they were on. I was fortunate enough to have a firm belief in God before I started my trek through the wilderness. That firm belief in God the Creator and the code that I live by, do unto others as you would have them do unto you, have served me well as a raft and a guide. Although I did make the mistake of joining the church my wife attended some years ago for the purpose of trying to satisfy her and maybe have a little social outlet, this was the biggest mistake I ever made. I only attended one Sunday of the month and I dreaded to see that Sunday come. I felt like the biggest hypocrite in the world sitting their listening to the preacher perform as I tried to keep a straight face. I bared it as long as I could, which wasn't very long, and then I stopped going. I don't know whether the preacher ever took my name

off the book but I am sure he will once he reads this book.

I am appealing to all of my Christian sisters and brothers to accept (the) truth that there is but one God, and reject (a) truth that there are three, God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost. And I am appealing to my Muslim sisters and brothers to stop following (a) truth that was revealed to Muhammad fourteen hundred years ago and join me in (the) truth that has been reveal to me in this time. Muhammad is dead but God lives on and if we accept (the) truth he will do the same for us as he did for the Arabs fourteen hundred years ago. God revealed (a) truth to Muhammad, the religion of Islam which means peace, and that was sufficient for that time and place but not sufficient for us in this time and place. But that same God has revealed to me (the) truth, the faith of Truth, which is universal and if we accept it, it is sufficient to lift us to great heights. And in my conclusion I would like to invite you to come and join me in my mission of spreading the Truth throughout the land to make my people aware of the time that we now live in.

A CALL FOR A SECOND NON-VIOLENT REVOLUTION

The first non-violent revolution was about civil rights, and to a large degree, was successful, but when we look around at our Black Communities today we plainly see that they are in need of another revolution of some sort, “but what sort”. When the unemployment rate in the Black communities is up to 58% while the national unemployment rate is down to 5%, the ratio of Blacks incarcerated as compared to Whites is off the chart, the upheaval of crimes and violence run rampant, we plays the slots machines instead of the stock markets, and we are the number one users of illegal drugs in the world. Nothing shy of a culture revolution could solve these problems, and the world is watching.

SHAME ON THE CLERGIES!!!

Can you handle the truth? A Clergy is a person who has mastered the art of standing behind the podium upon the pulpit bellowing out sermons that defies all logic and common sense but it sound so good that it make you want to jump up and shout. They call it preaching, I call it deceiving and I am calling them out on it. When attending their service, if you could close your mind and let your emotion do

it thing, then you would be in for one funky good time, but if you could control your emotion and let your mind do it thing, you would be in for one funky bad day. We accept them as our leaders but in reality they're no more than modern day Witch Doctors who mesmerize our minds with their elaborate emotional extravaganza and then relieve us of our money while assuring us of a heavenly reward that no one has never come back to verify. When you walk out of their place of deception, they are the only ones better off than when you walked in. The church is just as much a party place as the tavern. In one, you get high on alcohol, in the other, you get high on lies, and anyone who dare tell the truth is bound to be duded a party pooper, and no partier likes a party pooper. I am sorry partiers, but it is time for the truth.

As our Black community continues to sink deeper into a state of poverty and despair, we continue to look to the Clergies for their leadership but only get pacification while they get media gratification, but nothing ever changes. If we are ever going to change our condition we must accept the fact that our minds were put into a psychological box during slavery and the Black Clergies have served as the binders to keep them there by instilling the fear of the devil and fire and brimstone into us if

we dare let our mind think outside of the box. Until we lose the fear of thinking outside of that box our condition will continue to worsen because the solution lies outside of the box. The Clergies are afraid that if you think outside of the box you might conclude that instead of them being the solution to the problem that they are the problem. God is on the side of truth and truth never contradicts truth so you shouldn't be afraid to keep an open mind. One thing is certain, we, the African-American people, are in deep trouble and we cannot get out of it without the help of God. It is only through truth that we know God and you will know the truth when you hear it. I believe that there is only one God, God the Creator, and he has a personal relationship with each of us and in my relationship with him, he has revealed the truth to me and made it my mission to get it out to you and that is the purpose of me writing this document.

We are now living in the most crucial time in the history of civilization and God has chosen us, the descendants of slaves, to show the rest of the world that he and he alone is God and has chosen me to be the Messenger to deliver you the truth that will set your mind free, and I will do that.

When the Clergies come together and hold hands and pray after there has been a senseless shooting in our community, I know they mean well but they are

not solving the problem, the problem goes much deeper than that. The problem goes all the way back to the beginning of slavery and to solve it we must get to the root of it and that calls for some thinking outside of the box. If you analyze the current condition of the Black communities I think you would agree that nothing short of non-violence Cultural Revolution could change our worsening condition. How about that for thinking outside of the box? IT'S ON!!!

Now the question is what would a Cultural Revolution look like, what would be our goal, and what would have to be done to pull it off? The first and foremost thing is we must have God on our side, and to do that we must acknowledge his truth that he has revealed through his messenger. Secondly, we must obey the laws of the land. Our goal would be to channel the mind and energy of our youth into doing something constructive and away from gang violence. Another goal would be to strive to become self-sufficient and stop depending on others for our livelihood. But our primary goal would be to unite our people under one God. And now for the big question, how do we pull it off? Like in all revolutions, you have to fight the powers that be. So who are the powers that be in the Black communities? That leads us right back to the

Clergies, but the only weapon we need to defeat them is the truth that God has revealed to me and I am not afraid to use it. God is on the side of the truth. The non-violent cultural revolution is on! So let me explain to you how this culture revolution thing goes.

Here is how the two opposing sides stacks up. On one side are the African-American Christian, the side that you are probably already on, which number about fifty million. On the opposing side are the True Believers, which number only two at this time, me and God the Creator. I know those odds seem insurmountable but remember, this is a non-violence revolution, no fair hitting and carrying on, and God has armed me with the message of truth, and truth is to falsehood as light is to darkness. They may seek comfort in their numbers but their numbers cannot shield them from the truth. The biggest different between the True Believers and the Christians is that the True Believers believe in only one God, God the Creator, while the Christians believe in three Gods, the Trinity, God the Father, who is God the Creator, God the Son, and God the Holy Ghost. At a time when we are in such a desperate need of God's help we shouldn't go around lying on him by accusing him of having a child by another man's wife! I don't care how many people believe this lie that doesn't make it true. God is as real as you are, how would

you like it if someone was going around falsely accusing you of having a child by someone else's wife. I don't care how long we go around holding hands praying, God will not come to our aid until we acknowledge his truth, and then he will show the world that he and he alone is God.

It might seem as though I am attacking your faith, Christianity, but I am only defending my faith, which is in God the Creator, against the false accusation that he begot a son, a lie against God upon which is the very foundation that your faith, Christianity, is founded. Your faith is in religion and all religions have their tenet and dogma. My faith is in God and God is independent of religion and is on the side of truth. Instead of tenet and dogma I believe in truth and that why I refer to myself and those that believe as I do as True Believers, and I hope that you will accept the truth and become a True Believer also.

Whereas the religious believers worship their Gods at a certain day and time by observing certain ritual and making a lot of noise, the True Believer worship their God at all time by serving him, and we serve him by trying to do that which is right. The question is "Under which of these Faiths would we be better off, the Faith of religion or the Faith of Truth". We must remember that the founding fathers

of this country saw the wisdom of writing about the Separation of Government and Religion in the First Amendment of the U. S. Constitution. Can you imagine how messed up this country would be if they had not put that stipulation in the constitution, and religion is the only form of Government we, the African-Americans have? That is why we are in such a mess. I realize that you probably think that we don't need an African- American Government, and we are doing fine under the laws of the land. First of all I would like to make it crystal clear that I have no intention of violating the laws of the land but I envision an organization that function like a government for the True Believers only.

I believe this can and will be done in two phases. The first phase would be to create a ministry for the purpose of recruiting True Believers by spreading the message of Truth. This phase has already started, after reading The Message, if you believe as I believe, that there is but one God and that I am his Messenger, then you are a True Believer and I would like to hear from you and add your name to the book of life. After we have recruited a sufficient number of true believer then we would concentrate on building an organization that function like a government under the auspice of the ministry, meaning the ministry would be the overseer of the

second organization. The ministry will remain indefinite as a beacon of our faith in God, and the missions will always be a place of strength through communion and fellowship, there is strength in coming together with others of your faith.

I realize no matter how plain, simple, and clear, this book might be, the vast majority of you will not heed my calling until something drastic happens, and then we will recognize the danger of the time we live in and accept the truth that will save us from what lies ahead. The truth is non-negotiable, we cannot dictate the terms by which our lives are saved. I am calling for the tiny few of you who have the insight to see that the time for this movement is at hand and have the wisdom to be among the first to join, I will make you leaders and you would be generously rewarded. Don't hesitate to join this movement and be a participant of history in the making. America has done great as a world leader in the material world, but has fell miserable in the spiritual world of creed and morality, which is just as importance, if not more so. Although it claims democracy as it creed, it practice racism and greed as it deed. While the uses of science and industry have made America strong in the material world, the use of racism and greed has made it week in the ideological world. Where as they use science and

mathematics as their compass in the material world, they uses religious taboos as their compass in the ideological world, and it have led them into a moral quagmire from which they cannot escape.

We, the African-Americans, are at the bottom of that quagmire, but since we are not the cause of it, but victim of it, due to the process of slavery, God have made away for us to escape by accepting the Truth that he has revealed to his Messenger.

Now that you have finished reading the Message, you should have figured out by now where I stand on the Christian deity with the initial J C, I am so oppose to that fiction character until I refuse to write it name in this book. I know that this truth is a bitter pill for many of you to swallow and I have tried to make it as tasteless as possible by letting you figure it out yourself by reading the book. Every time I wrote that there was only one God, I was telling you that I did not believe in JC. I have brought the truth to you the best of my ability and hope that you will come and stand with me. I am thankful to God for giving me life and I would rather serve him by standing alone on the side of truth than to stand with a multitude of million on the side of falsehood, because I knows that he is with me.

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
